NET CONTROL INSTRUCTIONS
OCTOBER 15TH 2011**

PREAMBLE

Attention all Radio Operators, this is the annual "Simulated Emergency Test". This Province-Wide Exercise will be conducted on this frequency from _____ today.

SET is an official test of the Ontario ARES under the direction of Emergency Management Ontario, all ARES/EMCOMM Groups are requested to participate.

Check in's to this network will be taken in the following order;

- 1- Emergency Traffic (Declarations of Emergency)**
- 2- Priority Traffic (Incident Reports)**
- 3- Routine Traffic (All other check in's)**

When checking into this network please check in using your callsign only, when Net Control brings you into the network please provide the following information.

- 1- Your Callsign**
- 2- First Name**
- 3- Location**
- 4- ARES/EMCOMM Group affiliation**
- 5- Any traffic to list**

All stations are requested to stay on frequency unless excused by net control.

The net will now stand by for any stations with emergency traffic, please come now.

After all emergency traffic is passed

The net will now stand by for stations with priority traffic, please come now.

After all priority traffic is passed

The net will now stand by for routine traffic and all stations wishing to report into the network, please come now.

Repeat sequence until your hour is finished

1-Total number of check in's

2- Total number of messages passed

3- The callsign, name, location and ARES/EMCOMM Group affiliation for each check in.
